2020 "SOLUTIONS TO STORMWATER POLLUTION" CALENDAR CONTEST

Cowlitz Clean Waters, a collaborative initiative of local government agencies and educational partners, is sponsoring its third annual calendar contest to raise awareness of the solutions to stormwater pollution. Cowlitz Clean Waters is encouraging middle school students to tap their creativity to create artwork and write haikus illustrating and conveying the ways that we can stop stormwater pollution and keep our local streams, rivers and lakes clean and healthy. The twelve winning pieces of art and twelve haikus will be featured in the Cowlitz Clean Waters' 2020 "Solutions to Stormwater Pollution" Calendar. This year's theme for the calendar is "Every Little Action Can Improve Water Quality."

CONTEST RULES

- 1. The contest is open to all middle school students in Cowlitz County (i.e. enrolled in 6th 8th grade at a public, private or home school within Cowlitz County).
- 2. Each entry must be accompanied by a completed *Contest Entry Form* signed by the student and parent/guardian.
- 3. Each student may submit one (1) piece of art and one (1) haiku. Each will be considered a separate entry and will require a separate completed *Contest Entry Form*.
- 4. The format for artwork is 8.5" x 11" with a horizontal (landscape) orientation.
- 5. Students may use the following media to create their artwork: crayons, ink, pencil, colored pencils, acrylic, oils, watercolors, tempera, chalks, etc. Photography and computer-generated artwork will not be accepted.
- 6. Haikus should be in a traditional format (please see http://www.kathimitchell.com/poemtypes.html).
- 7. Artwork must be ORIGINAL work by the student (no traced, trademarked, or copyrighted characters or graphics). Others may not participate in producing the student's artwork or haiku.
- 8. Each artwork or haiku must depict one of the following topics (see the Cowlitz Clean Waters website below for a poster that has tips and behavior changes for these topics):
 - Keep your Vehicle Clean and Green
 - A Little Goes a Long Way
 - Scoop the Poop
 - Don't Blow It

- Don't Drip & Drive
- Put Waste in its Place
- Spread the Word

PRIZES

- Grand Prize for best artwork: \$350 Amazon gift card Artwork will be featured on the cover of the calendar
- Eleven Runner-up Prizes for artwork selected for the calendar: \$50 Amazon gift card
- Twelve \$25 Amazon gift cards for each haiku selected for the calendar

JUDGING CRITERIA

- Ability of the submission to illustrate/convey ways to reduce and prevent stormwater pollution and keep our local streams, rivers and lakes clean and healthy
- Artistic quality of the submission
- Adherence to the Contest Rules

CONTEST DEADLINE AND SUBMITTAL

The contest deadline is 5 pm on Wednesday, November 6, 2019.

All submissions <u>must be received</u> by the deadline – *Note that postmarks do not count*.

Original artwork should be delivered or sent in a flat sturdy envelope or box (please do not roll artwork into tubes or fold artwork since these damage entries for reproduction purposes). Haiku submissions can be sent via email with a scanned copy of the entry form.
